A. FINANCE

She will be compensated \$265 a month (to cover her Medicare expenses) instead of the Village paying \$1200 a month to insure her. Mr. Slade read the Treasurers Report and the tax revenues aloud during the meeting.

B. ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

Chris DeSchepper was present in committee to give a Durand Charm update. The Disc Golf Course is moving forward. The proposed installation date is Saturday, November 24th. The name will be "Creekside Disc Golf Course." Candy Cane Lane will be this Sunday, November 18th from 9am-4pm. Mrs. Hoffman reported that the website is live and updated the rest of the Board about the progress she's made. Eli from Astute Web Group suggested using a different domain name (villageofdurand.com) so Sheila purchased that domain.

C. BUILDINGS AND PARKS

Summer help is done this week. Bathrooms at the park have been closed for the winter.

D. STREETS AND ALLEYS

Mr. Ingram reported that Mr. Bryden was concerned about the parking spaces in the square for larger extended cab trucks and the driving lane being too narrow with Option #1 since the roadway will be 3 feet narrower. When parked on opposite sides of the street there is 15 ½ feet between the two vehicles with the current set-up. Mr. Ingram found this to be adequate driving space with the current set-up and with Option #1's set-up.

E. WATER AND SEWER

President Corwin and Mr. Kahl are meeting with Mick tomorrow in Rockford and invited Mrs. Waller to go with to discuss the well project.

F. POLICE

Everyone on the police department is qualified by Iron Sights. The Village is looking into a 50/50 grant for new bullet proof vests.
