COMMITTEE REPORTS

A. FINANCE

A meeting was held last week concerning the 1% Sales Tax Lockbox. Funds generated through the sales tax increase will be divided between Parks, Infrastructure, and Police. The Illinois Department of Revenue estimates that \$233,014.44 would have been received by the Village as a result for years 2018, 2019, 2020.

B. ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

The Declaration of Local State of Emergency has been extended. Sheila Hoffman is continuing to work with interested parties concerning a possible clock donation for the square. The Board would prefer something that is currently in the project concept. The Village Website has been updated to reflect the need for a Zoning Administrator. Interested parties can call Village Hall.

C. BUILDINGS AND PARKS

Dark Gray was picked for the new Village Hall roof. The Old Holiday Hall, where Bob Farmer stores numerous items, collapsed under the weight of the snow on the roof. Several people, including Kelsey Excavating and Kim Stewart, have volunteered to clean the area as soon as the snow melts.

D. STREETS AND ALLEYS

Aaron Kahl thanked the board for the new plow truck.

E. WATER AND SEWER

Jill Pepin gave a projects' update on the Waste Water Project funding and the Durand Square Project.

F. POLICE

A meeting was held on February 17th to begin planning the 4th of July festivities. The fireworks and parade will be held this year. The next meeting will be on March 18th. The portable Police Radios have been sent to Motorola to be programmed. A Resolution for the radios will be voted on tonight. House Bill 3653 passed today and Chief Schelling will keep the board updated on it.
