# **COMMITTEE REPORTS**

#### A. FINANCE

The Board discussed appointing Craig Cox to the open Trustee position that was recently vacated with Trustee Slade's resignation. The appointment is up for a vote tonight. The Board discussed the bond funding for the Square Project. It will be a ten-year bond in the amount of \$400,000 and should be received by the end of December.

#### **B. ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT**

Kelly Giovanine presented the board with an update on Durand C.H.A.R.M. The Board discussed an annual raffle permit license and decided the Ordinance will remain unchanged at this time. The Board discussed the Resolution regarding the advisory question on raising chickens within Village limits that will appear on the next ballot. Attorney Burke is working on the details.

### C. BUILDINGS AND PARKS

Code Enforcement Officer Randy Ketchum was present to discuss code issues in the Village. The Thomas Building was discussed, as was illegal dumping of properties abutting the Otter Creek Farm. The buildings have been condemned by Winnebago County and the property is set to be sold on December 16<sup>th</sup>, 2022.

#### D. STREETS AND ALLEYS

The handrails on the Square were installed and will need to be adjusted. Some benches may need to be moved due to complaints about the current location. The Village will ask I.D.O.T. and Fehr Graham if this is possible. There have been complaints about the smell and design of the ashtrays.

## **E. WATER AND SEWER**

The trusses and roof should be on Well #3 this week.

# F. POLICE

Solicitors Permit Ordinance Changes were discussed and is on the agenda for a vote tonight. Five K-9 units assisted in a K-9 search of Durand School District #322. Nothing notable was found. The purchase, training and deployment of tasers for the Durand Police Officers cost \$599. A potential Police Department candidate from Arizona is being looked into. The Board discussed a possible increase in pay for current part-time Police Officers.
