A. FINANCE

Kyle Demus of Benning Group was present to present the results of the last fiscal year audit, ending on April 30th, 2024. Litigation against the Village of Durand, Sheila Hoffman, Leann Clark, and Michael Reiman has been resolved.

B. ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

The Queen of Hearts raffle has a jackpot of over \$32,000 and is increasing. The Lion's Club has provided information of a restricted account in lieu of a bond. The Illinois Housing Association presented statistics and survey results for potential developers on October 21st, 2024. Trick or Treat hours are October 31st, 2024 from 5:00-7:30. D.A.R.T.S. has requested a road closure for a holiday event in conjunction with Durand Charm to take place the weekend of December 8th, 2024. The board discussed outdoor dining and the possible implementation of an entertainment district.

C. BUILDINGS AND PARKS

The property at 14730 Ruby St has had a hearing postponed until a November/December timeframe. No further update is available.

D. STREETS AND ALLEYS

The State St. fog seal has been completed, which honored last year's bid. Waste Management has provided a new app for Garbage Services and Sticker sales. The letter went out this week.

E. WATER AND SEWER

The controls for the pump at the lift station need to be replaced and the parts should be installed on October 29th, 2024.

F. POLICE

Both part-time officers are now on their own. Damage was done to the gazebo on the square and restitution has been made. A video presentation was made of the taser 10 and a grant has been awarded for three Taser 10s to the Village. The SRO car is decaled and ready. The third body cam has been received and the radio is in Rockford for programming. Four candidates are currently being considered, with interviews to begin the first part of November.
